Curriculum for Life

Assessment

At Nine Mile Ride Primary School we want to see every child reach their full potential, no matter what their starting point.

We use assessment to:

- raise standards for all;
- motivate and involve children in their learning;
- inform and involve parents in their child's learning.

We track what a child can do, and what they need to do to move to make progress. It reflects the National Curriculum and allows teachers to plan lessons to address gaps in learning.

Teachers use a wide range of assessment information and their own judgements to determine the achievement levels of each child and parents are kept up to date each term.

We are passionate about creating the right environment where children are nurtured, achieve and have their moments to shine.



Character for Life

In order for our children to thrive, they need to be happy to learn and we place very high importance on the mental health of our pupils so that they understand themselves and their emotions and can make the most of their own individual talents.

Nine Mile Ride Primary School pupils learn to be resilient in the face of setbacks; know how to keep themselves safe and healthy; understand the society that they live in and become a valued member of the community. Life can be a roller coaster; however, learning to put things into context and be happy is very important.

Thrive

We believe that a safe and nurturing environment develops healthy, happy, confident pupils who are ready and open to learning.

The 'Thrive' approach, draws on insights from the fields of neuroscience, attachment theory and child development to provide a powerful way of working with pupils that supports optimal social and emotional development.

We aim to bring together the development of the whole child, developing confidence, and ultimately success, in our students. Dance

Dance is an integral part of the Arts and we have several dance programmes, including cheer leading, hip hop, street dance and curriculum time dance. Children are given the opportunity to perform during the year in school and beyond and highlights include children having the opportunity to showcase their skills in front of their peers and also audiences of hundreds.





Drama

Drama plays a part at Nine Mile Ride Primary School with many performances for all age groups taking place. Christmas productions, talent shows, Key Stage productions, poetry readings and workshops are all part of the drama calendar at the school.

Art

The classrooms showcase pupils' artwork so that all pupils' develop an appreciation for visual art and the standard of work produced is very high. Children are given the opportunity to experiment with different media, such as clay, paint, collage through dedicated art sessions and cross-curricular work.

At Nine Mile Ride Primary School, each child has the opportunity to engage in a wide variety of physical education activities, which includes both indoor and outdoor sessions. This is delivered either by the highly skilled class teacher or dedicated sports instructor and visiting specialists.

Our varied sport programme encourages teamwork, and we actively encourage as many pupils as possible to represent the school in whatever capacity and at all levels; not just the most able.

We provide pupils with excellent quality and varied sporting opportunities with children experiencing and participating in well over 30 different sports.

It is our belief that sport is an essential part of school life and develops the whole child. The many benefits include health, fitness, a growth mind set and the sense of achievement and value that active participation and successful competition can bring.

Healthy Choices

As part of our sporting programme and cross-curricular links, our pupils learn about the importance of exercise, diet and making healthy life choices. This includes a focus on physical as well as mental health.

The school is proud of its link with many external sports clubs, including Reading FC as part of their Premier League Primary Stars programme.

The school is proud to hold the Platinum Award for Sport which is evidence that sport is an integral part of what we do at Nine Mile Ride Primary School.
